

SATISFACTION OF JUDGMENT

INSTRUCTIONS TO PLAINTIFF

If you were issued a Judgment in your favor and if you have been paid in full, you are advised that W.S. §1-21-401 requires that every person recovering a Judgment in Court who receives payment shall file a Satisfaction of Judgment with the Court within fifteen (15) days after receiving payment. Failure to comply is a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not less than \$25 nor more than \$200.

Please note that it must be signed before a Notary Public or a Justice Court Clerk.
